



## **Travel Grants Programme for Students and Post-Docs**

The Cannabinoid Conference 2015 is pleased to announce the availability of the following type of student/postDoc travel grants sponsored by the ISN (International Society of Neurochemistry). Applicants will be notified of the decision by email.

### **The eligibility criteria include**

Applications are available for qualified full-time graduate students and/or young post-Doc (max 3 years following PhD). To qualify, a student must:

- (i) be a valid Student at the time of application;
- (ii) be either a full-time student registered toward a Bachelors, Masters, or Ph.D. degree or a young Post-Doc (max 3 years following PhD) in a related field to Cannabinoid Research when submitting the application;
- (iii) be an author of a paper in form of either poster or oral presentation at this Cannabinoid Conference.

### **Application Procedure**

An application for a student travel award will consist of:

1. A motivation letter from the student/young Post-Doc
2. The abstract that will be presented by the student/young Post-Doc in oral or poster form
3. The student/young Post-Doc's CV (maximum 2 pages).
4. A supporting letter from the advisor (see below for detailed information).
5. An estimate of the following costs of attending Cannabinoid Conference 2015: airfare, hotel, and conference registration. It is anticipated that travel grants will partially cover these overall costs of attending Cannabinoid Conference 2015.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

### **The motivation letter from the student should include (at most 1 page)**

1. A brief summary of research interests and accomplishments to date.
2. A description of areas reflected in the Cannabinoid Conference 2015 program that would impact the student's research, and a statement about why the conference attendance is important to the student.

**The advisor's recommendation letter for the student should include**

1. Confirmation that student is a bona fide full-time Ph.D. or M.S. candidate or PostDoc in good academic standing at the given institution.
2. Why this particular student would benefit from attendance at the conference.
3. The strengths and potential contributions of the student.

Applicants should upload their applications through the website. Applicants should send their application materials as a single PDF file, following the instructions in the Travel Grants section on Cannabinoid Conference 2015 site.
